Admission to the five year Integrated course in Botany shall be open to a candidate who has passed/appeared in Higher Secondary Part Two examinations (10+2 pattern) JKBOSE or examinations recognised as equivalent thereto, with Physics, Chemistry & Biology and with at least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST Candidate)

Sub clause 16.3.3.10

INTEGRATED M.SC HONORS PROGRAMME IN ZOOLOGY

Admission to the five year Integrated course in Zoology shall be open to a candidate who has passed/appeared in Higher Secondary Part Two examinations (10+2 pattern) JKBOSE or examinations recognised as equivalent thereto, with Physics, Chemistry & Biology and with at least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST Candidate)

Sub clause 16.3.3.11

PG INTEGRATED LINGUISTICS AND LITERATURE

Admission to the five year M.A. Linguistics shall be open to a candidate who has passed/appeared in Higher Secondary Part Two examinations (10+2 pattern) JKBOSE or examinations recognised as equivalent thereto, with at least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST Candidate)

Sub clause 16.3.3.12

INTEGRATED M.A. HONORS PROGRAMME IN HISTORY: CULTURAL HERITAGE

Admission to the five year Integrated course in History shall be open to a candidate who has passed/appeared in Higher Secondary Part Two examinations (10+2 pattern) JKBOSE or examinations recognised as equivalent thereto, with at least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST Candidate).

3. Modification of Clause 3.12 of Chapter-3 pertaining to Workload of Teachers by adopting the revised guidelines of workload of Teachers as approved by the University Council vide Resolution No. 20

		The staffing pattern of the University Departments/ Centers shall be worked out on the basis of the above norms subject to the following:
	i.	A department shall ordinarily have a minimum of one Professor, two Associate Professors and three Assistant Professors as per the UGC recommended staff pattern.
	ii.	A lecture class shall ordinarily not have more than 60 students.
	iii.	A tutorial class shall ordinarily not have more than 20 students.
	iv.	A laboratory class shall ordinarily not have more than 15 students.
	v.	A Post-graduate/Integrated Programme/ UG General/ Honors Programme, with lecture/tutorial of one hour duration.
	vi.	A teacher shall ordinarily teach courses equivalent to a total of 8 credits (core and/or optional) in a semester.
	vii.	The time table shall ordinarily be spread over 8 hours a day in a five-day week/06 hours in a six day week, in order to accommodate the various academic activities.
	viii.	All teachers in the department shall share equally in all forms of duty.
	ix.	University teachers shall spend at least 5 hours a day in the Department.
4.	Adoption of M.Sc./M.A. Mathematics (Evening Course on Self Financing basis) from the Academic session 2019-20 as given in Annexure-I shall be incorporated in the new Chapter-21 of the University Calendar entitled "Self Financing Courses" as Clause 21.1 duly approved by the University Council vide Resolution No.21.	
5.	Adoption of Regulations governing Self Financing Courses Fund as given in Annexure-II shall be incorporated in Chapter-12 entitled "Local Funds of the University" as clause 12.10 duly approved by the University Council vide Resolution No. 21.	
6.	Adoption of Self Financing Certificate Courses of 3/6 months duration alongwith parameters as given in annexure III shall be incorporated in new Chapter-21 entitled "Self Financing Courses" as clause 21.2 duly approved by the University Council vide Resolution No. 22.	
7.	Adoption of Self Financing Post Graduate Diploma in Accountancy alongwith the guidelines as given in annexure IV shall be incorporated in new Chapter-21 entitled "Self Financing Courses" as clause 21.3 duly approved by the University Council vide Resolution No. 23.	
8.	Adoption of Regulations governing Cultural & Literary activities as given in Annexure-V shall be incorporated in new Chapter-22 entitled "Regulations governing Cultural and Literary Activities" as Clause 22.1 Campus Cultural Committee & Clause 22.2 Students Cultural Council duly approved by the University Council vide Resolution No. 25.
